Assembly Instructions for **In the Breeze** Next Generation Hot Air Balloons







Slide the plastic hub upward toward the top of the fiberglass pole, away from the basket.

Resting the bottom of the basket on a hard surface insert one end of a balloon panel in a hole in the basket and the other end in the top hub.

Continue this process for all of the remaining panels. If necessary press down on the plastic hub to make inserting the fiberglass frames easier.

To allow the balloon to spin make sure the fins are exposed like the bottom image. You may need to make some minor adjustments to the panels to finalize the balloon shape. *Note: Next Generation Hot Air Balloons are available with 6, 8 and 10 panels. Pictured is the 10 panel version.*

The pressure created during assembly should be sufficient to keep panels in place, but for use in high wind areas you may consider applying epoxy glue during assembly.

Be sure to hang balloon in an area that is free from all obstacles.
